- (1) Road Switcher service may be established at Cleburne, Texas, in accordance with governing Road Switcher Agreement, i.e., operating on a 25-mile radius from the home terminal point. This agreement is necessary for two reasons. First, the Cleburne Seniority District road crews have no seniority rights to work south of Cleburne. Second, because of the service requirements to provide switching to Brazlime at Mile Post 300.2 on the Fort Worth Subdivision it will be necessary for operational purposes to extend the 25-mile radius by approximately one mile to Mile Post 292.
- (2) This agreement in no way gives Northern Division employees any seniority rights on the Southern Division other than that provided for in the Cleburne Run Through Agreement.
- (3) Holiday pay rules will be applicable to employees assigned to this road switcher the same as though the limits of assignment did not exceed the 25-mile radius.
- (4) This Agreement is subject to cancellation by either party serving ten (10) days' written notice on the other.
